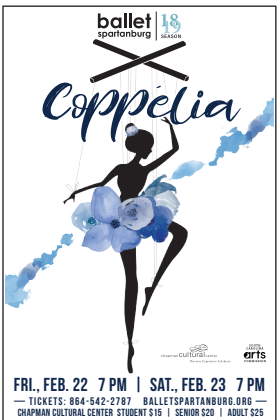
**BEAUTY AND THE BEAST**

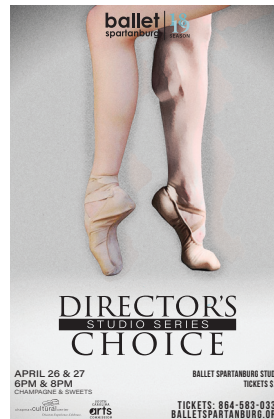
**COPPELIA**
